

WHAT IS THE NEW ROUTE 109 FORDEN-SHIPYARD?

Wave Transit's ongoing Reimagine Wave Transit study is recommending changes to bus service to make routes more direct, less duplicative, and easier to understand. **Due to uncertain funding levels, we are seeking your feedback on how services could change based on 30% less funding, existing funding levels, and 30% more funding.**

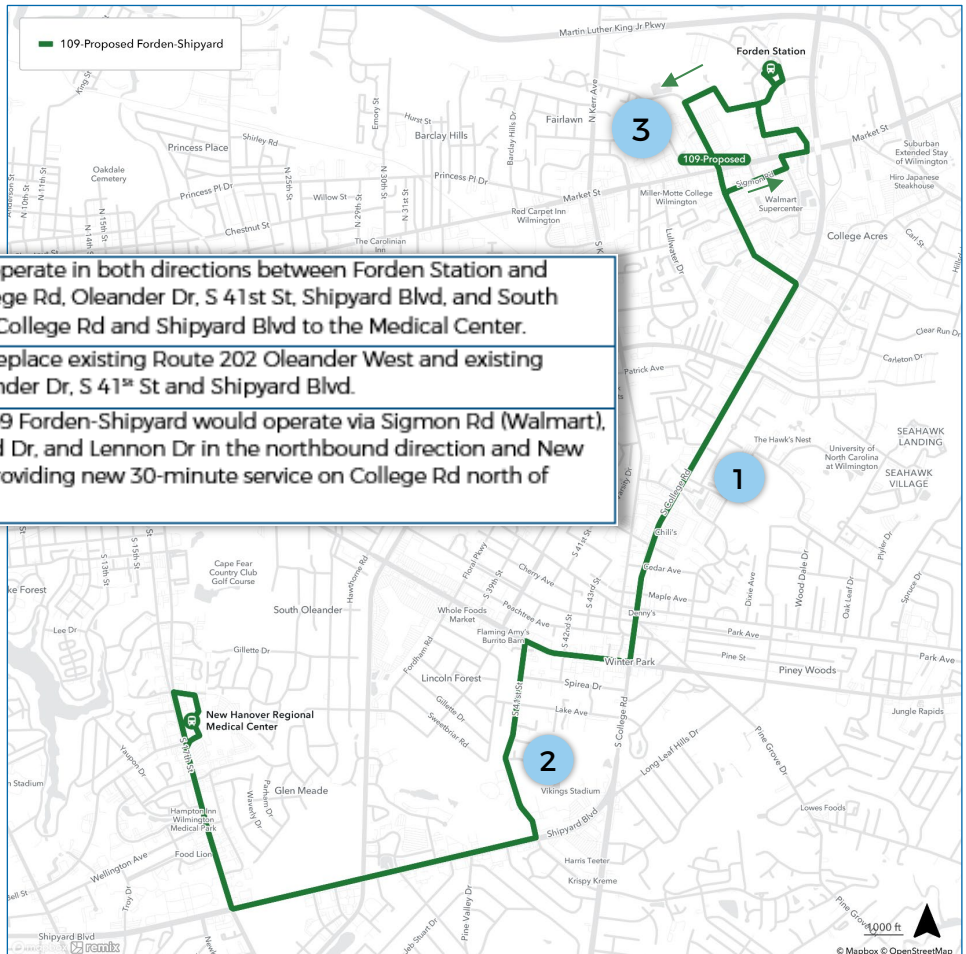

What is Route 109's routing for the three funding scenarios?

For all three funding scenarios, new Route 109 Forden-Shipyard would operate in both directions between Forden Station and Medical Center via **New Centre Dr, S College Rd, Oleander Dr, S 41st St, Shipyard Blvd, and S 17th St**. It is designed to replace parts of existing Route 103 Oleander East and Route 202 Oleander West.

- *NEW May 2024*** In response to public feedback, we're recommending adding additional new stops on College Road at Randall Parkway and at Fountain Drive to improve access.



1	New Route 109 Forden-Shipyard would operate in both directions between Forden Station and Medical Center via New Centre Dr, S College Rd, Oleander Dr, S 41st St, Shipyard Blvd, and South 17th St. This would improve access from College Rd and Shipyard Blvd to the Medical Center.
2	New Route 109 Forden-Shipyard would replace existing Route 202 Oleander West and existing Route 103 Oleander East service on Oleander Dr, S 41st St and Shipyard Blvd.
3	Both Route 107 College Rd and Route 109 Forden-Shipyard would operate via Sigmon Rd (Walmart), Van Campen Blvd, Market St, Gingerwood Dr, and Lennon Dr in the northbound direction and New Centre Dr in the southbound direction, providing new 30-minute service on College Rd north of Oleander Dr every day of the week.



Under a **reduced funding scenario**, what is the proposed schedule for Route 109 Forden-Shipyard?

- Route 109 Forden-Shipyard would operate **hourly seven days a week**.
- **New 30-minute service on New Centre Dr and College Rd north of Oleander would be provided seven days a week by new Route 109 Forden-Shipyard and Route 107 College Rd operating on the same streets between Forden Station and Oleander Dr** and departing 30 minutes after each other.

Weekdays (Monday-Friday)	5:30 AM – 7:30 PM: Every 60 min
Saturdays	8:00 AM – 6:00 PM: Every 60 min
Sundays	8:30 AM – 4:30 PM: Every 60 min



Under a **funding-neutral scenario**, what is the proposed schedule for Route 109 Forden-Shipyard?

- Route 109 Forden-Shipyard would operate **hourly seven days a week**.
- **New 30-minute service on New Centre Dr and College Rd north of Oleander would be provided seven days a week by new Route 109 Forden-Shipyard and Route 107 College Rd operating on the same streets between Forden Station and Oleander Dr** and departing 30 minutes after each other.

Weekdays (Monday-Friday)	6:00 AM – 8:00 PM: Every 60 min
Saturdays	8:00 AM – 6:00 PM: Every 60 min
Sundays	9:00 AM – 5:00 PM: Every 60 min



Under an **increased funding scenario**, what is the proposed schedule for Route 109 Forden-Shipyard?

- Route 109 Forden-Shipyard would operate **hourly seven days a week. It would operate for more hours of the day compared to the other funding scenarios**.
- **New 30-minute service on New Centre Dr and College Rd north of Oleander would be provided seven days a week by new Route 109 Forden-Shipyard and Route 107 College Rd operating on the same streets between Forden Station and Oleander Dr** and departing 30 minutes after each other.
